Spring Cleanup Recap!

Texas Land Commissioner Dawn Buckingham, M.D. announced that more than 4,500 volunteers participated along with her during the 2023 Adopt-A-Beach Coastwide Spring Cleanup this past April. During the one-day event, a total of 73,032 pounds of trash was removed from 22 unique sites that stretched all the way from Port Arthur to South Padre.

"One of our greatest responsibilities is the stewardship of our coastal lands and the habitats and ecosystems they support," said Commissioner Buckingham. "As Land Commissioner and former resident of Galveston Island, it was truly an honor to come together with Texans and volunteers from around the country to do our part to care for these beautiful beaches. With over 73,000 pounds of trash removed from the coast in a single day, there can be no doubt that the General Land Office's Adopt-A-Beach program will continue ensuring a better future for Texas beaches for generations to come."

The Texas General Land specialty license plate design features a photo by Texas' own Kenny Braun. Braun's work has been featured in Garden and Gun, Texas Monthly, Wired, Southern Living, Texas Highways, This Old House Magazine and more.

The plates are available to purchase for \$30 in addition to your annual registration fee, with \$22 of that donated to the Adopt-A-Beach program's all-volunteer effort to keep trash off Texas beaches.

The license plate was designed by the Texas General Land Office in coordination with the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles. To order a specialty Adopt-A-Beach license plate and get yours, visit texasadoptabeach.org/contribute/license-plates/
